### Herron Scholarship



### **Application Review Process**

- A completed application, including deposit, is required to be considered for a Samford Abroad program. Students must have at least a 2.5 GPA and no values violations at the time of application.
- Applications will be reviewed holistically; a variety of factors, including but not limited to date of application and deposit submission will be considered.
- A completed application is not a guarantee of acceptance to a program. Acceptances will be announced in February 2019.
- If a program does not meet minimum enrollments, or if a program is full and a student is waitlisted, the student will be offered the opportunity to move their application or receive a deposit refund.
